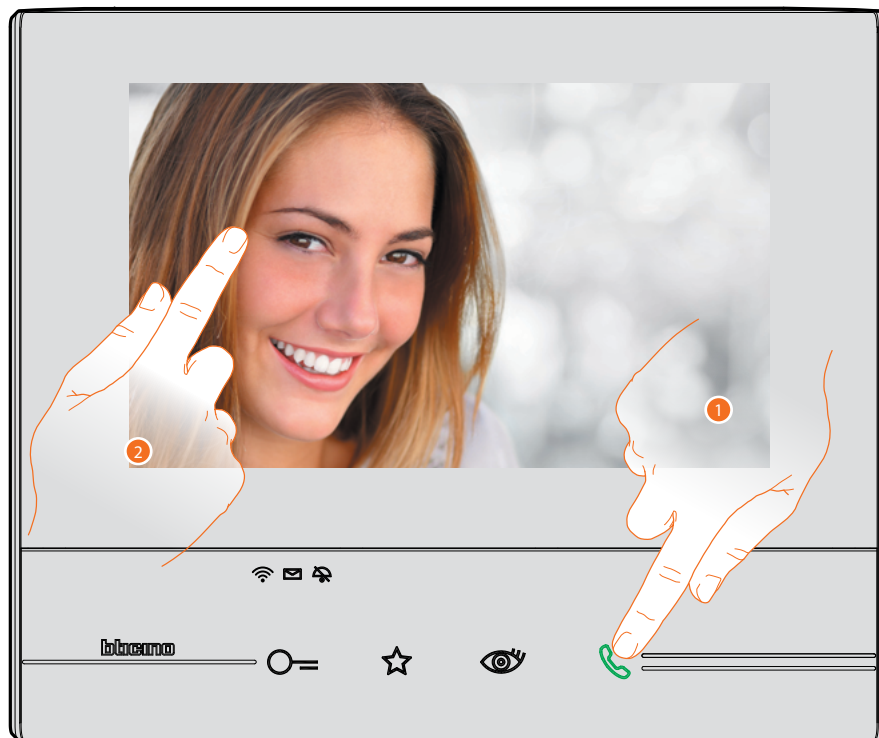

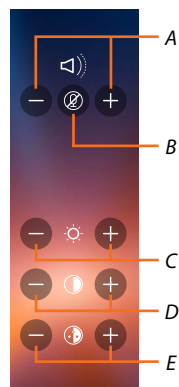
Answer a call



1. Touch to answer the call, the LED comes on steady. To end the call touch the connection key again.
2. If necessary, during the call touch the screen to display the audio/video adjustment icons.



3. Touch the icons  and  to adjust the parameters.



- A. Adjust the volume.
- B. Disable the microphone.
- C. Adjust the image brightness.
- D. Adjust the image contrast.
- E. Adjust the image colour.



- 4. Touch to open the Entrance Panel door lock.
The door lock key lights up briefly, to indicate that the door lock has been released.

Listen to the video door entry answering machine

When there are one or more unread messages in the answering machine, the home page that opens when clicking the answering machine icon shows a numeric indication, and the memo LED flashes.



1. Touch to enter the answering machine and display the message.



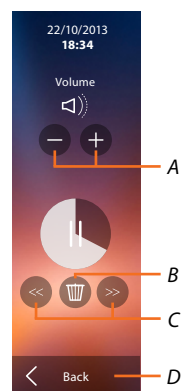
2. Touch to open the message.

The message is played back automatically




3. Touch to pause or restart playback.

The message can be managed using the appropriate icons:



- A. Adjust the volume.
- B. Delete the message.
- C. Beginning and end of message.
- D. Return to the answering machine screen.

the message status indication automatically switches to “read” , and the numeric indication disappears from the home page



5. Touch to return to the home page.

Auto-switching on and camera scrolling

Any cameras installed in the system can be accessed using the dedicated section, or using the automatic switching on key.



1. Touch to display the cameras in your system.

The corresponding key comes on and the display shows the images recorded by the camera of the associated Entrance Panel.

For the camera adjustments see [Answer a call](#).



2. The connection key flashes; touch this key to enable audio communication.



3. Touch to display another camera (scrolling). When switching from one camera to the next, the key lights up.

To end camera display mode wait for the switching off time to elapse.

Note: switching from one camera to another is also possible without enabling the audio.

Write or record a memo

It is possible to type a memo, or record a voice message for another user.

Typed memos may then be modified by the recipient, or the same can enter a new one.



1. Touch to write and/or record a memo.



2. Touch to write a memo.

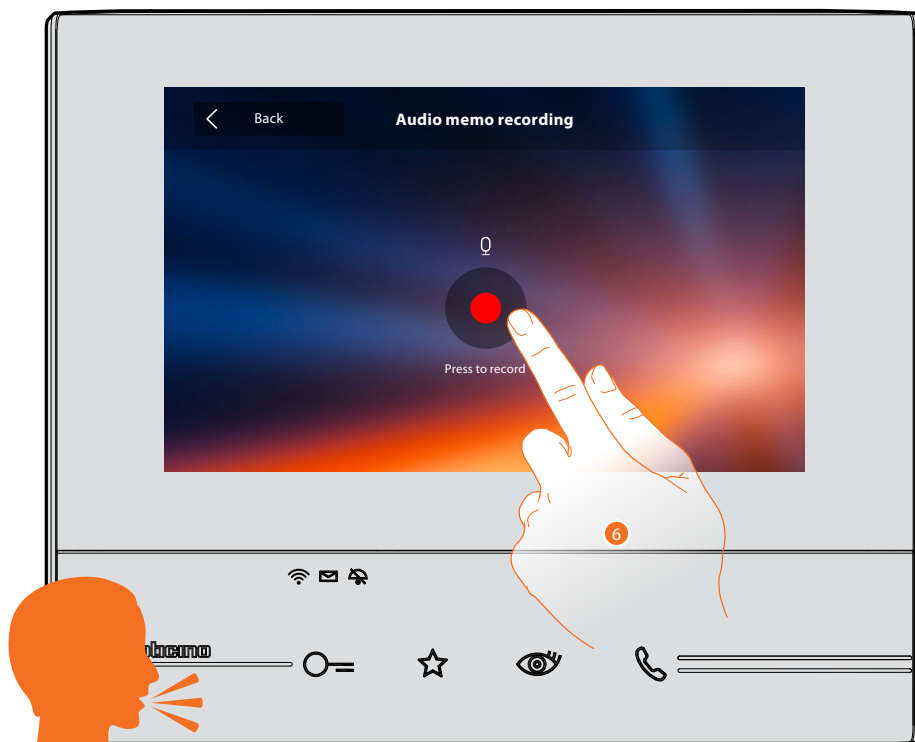


3. Use the keypad to write.
4. Touch to save the text memo.

Note: any unsaved memos will be lost.



5. Touch to record an audio memo.



6. Press record and record the audio memo.



7. Touch to stop recording, or wait for the set time to elapse.



8. Touch to listen to the audio memo.

9. Touch to save the audio memo.

Note: any unsaved memos will be lost.

Call another room or apartment (Intercom)

It is possible to communicate with another device installed in another room of the apartment or with a device of another apartment.



1. Touch to display the available intercoms.



2. Touch to activate the communication with the desired intercom.



Key (A) lights up to indicate that the call is active.



When the recipient answers the call, the audio adjustment icons appear; see [Answer a call](#).

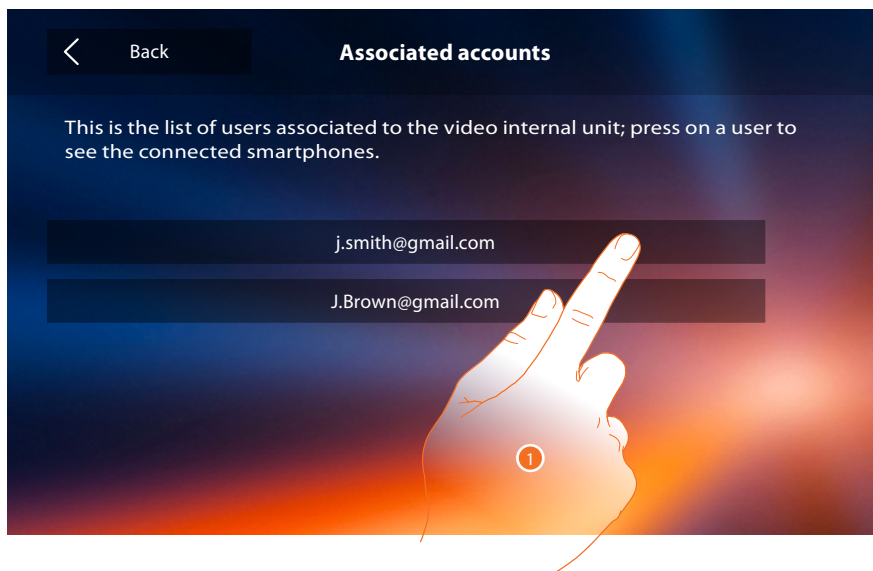
Note: when a call is received from the Entrance Panel while the internal unit is in "intercom" mode, the system follows the priority rules and ends the active call.

3. Touch to end the call.

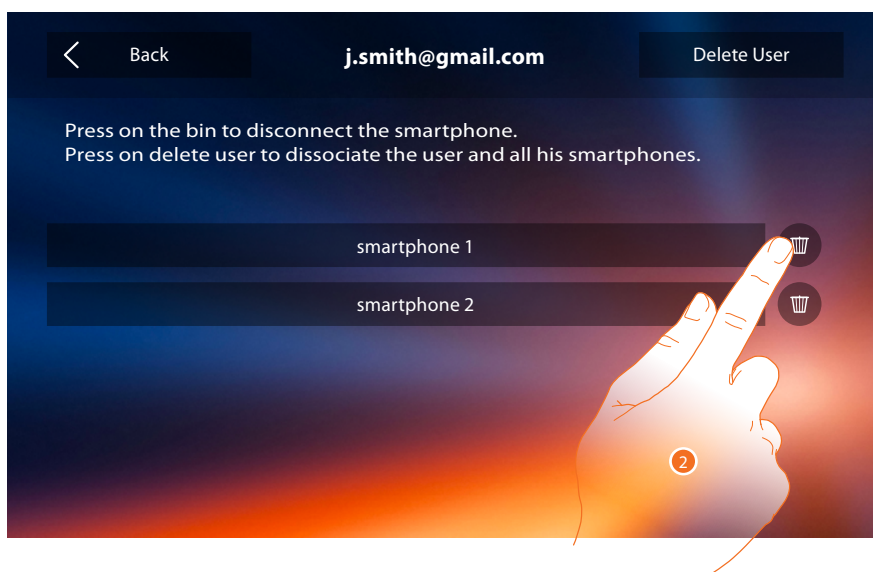
Disconnect a smartphone from the system

When you want to make it impossible for a smartphone connected to a user to be able to continue to interact with your Classe 300X (e.g. smartphone fault), you must disconnect it from the user itself.

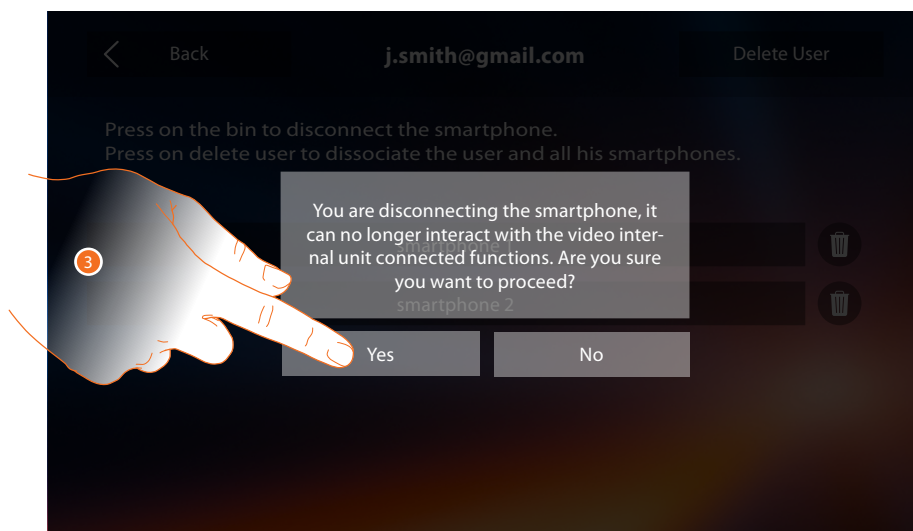

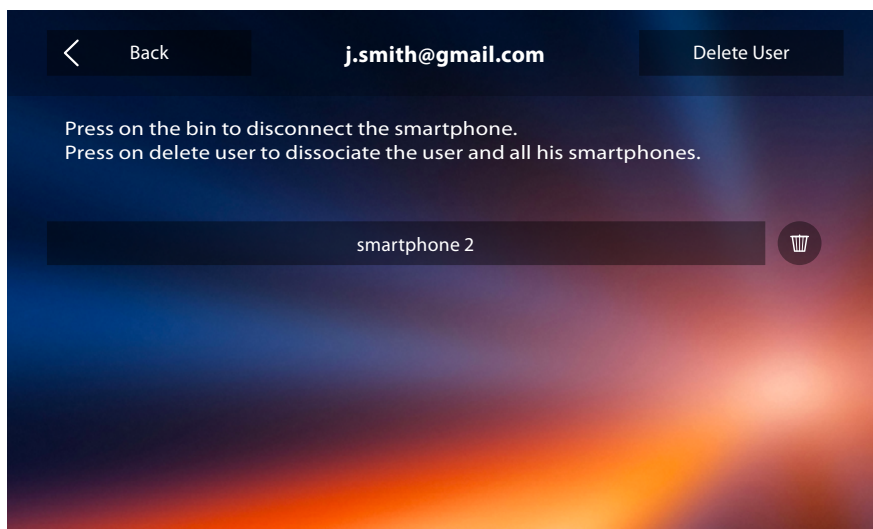
1. Touch to display the smartphones connected to the user.



2. Touch to disconnect the smartphone.



3. Touch to save it.



Note: to connect the smartphone to the Classe 300X again, authenticate using the [DOOR ENTRY APP](#).

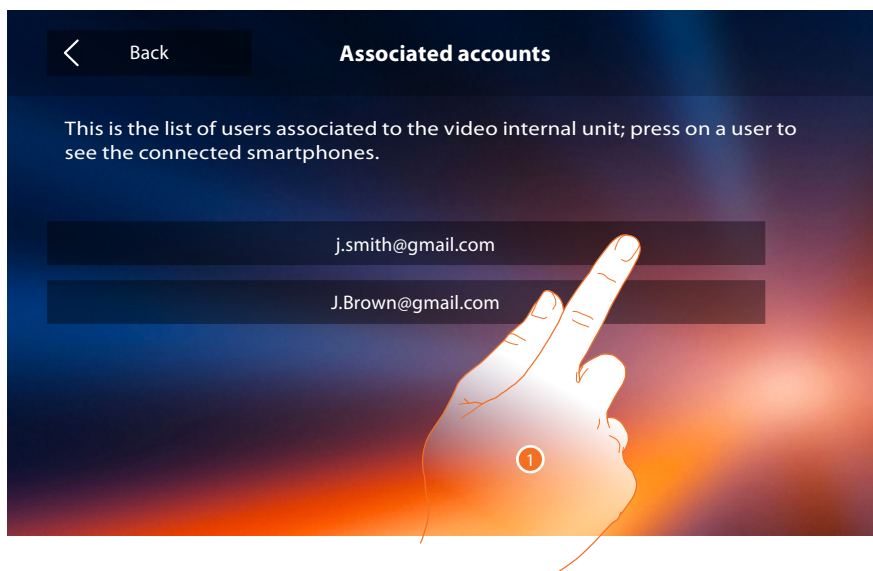
Dissociate a user from the system

When you want to make it impossible for a user to be able to continue to interact with your Classe 300X (e.g. smartphone stolen), you must disconnect it from the system.

You can carry out this procedure either from the Classe 300X or if not available from the [DOOR ENTRY APP](#).

Using the Classe 300X:

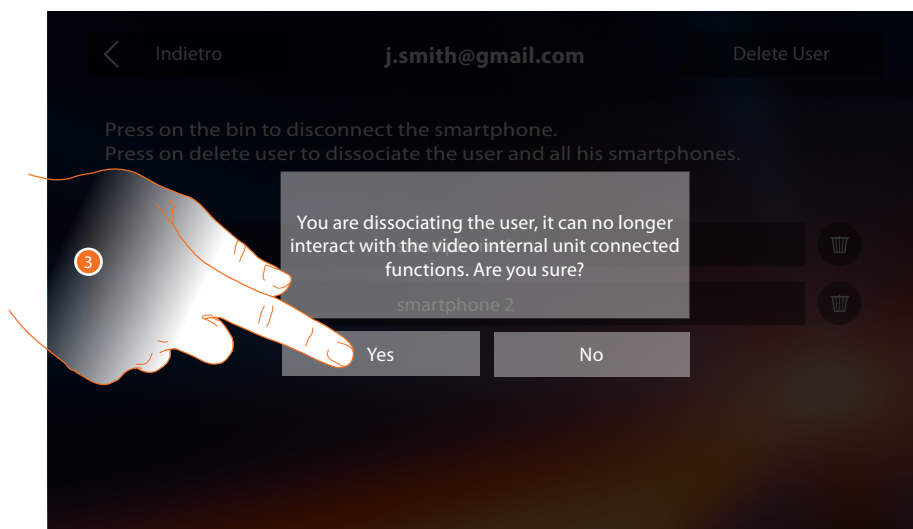

1. Touch to manage the user.



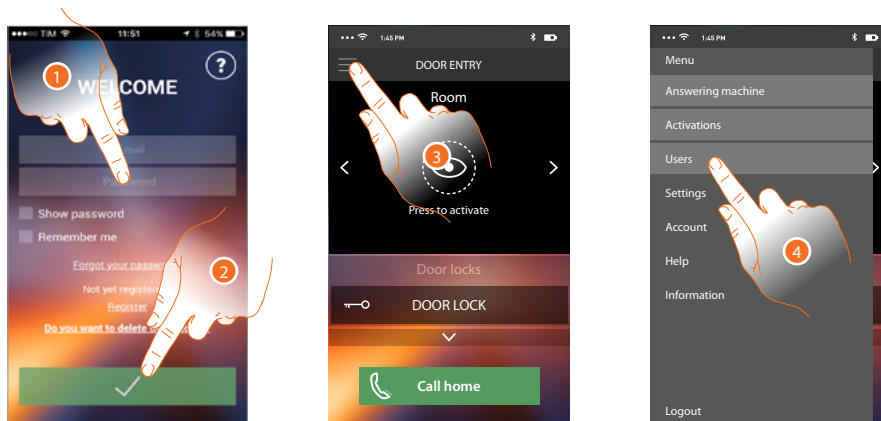
2. Touch to dissociate the user.



3. Touch to save it.

Using the smartphone

As the smartphone is not available (e.g. it has been stolen), authenticate with the credentials of the user to be disassociated using another smartphone.



1. Enter the login and password of the user to be disassociated.
2. Touch to authenticate.
3. Touch to open the settings menu.
4. Touch to open the user section.



5. Touch to dissociate the user.

Note: To associate your user again, it is necessary that another user invites you or, if there are no other users, make the association procedure again.

Function keys and status LEDs

Icon	Meaning
Door lock key	During the connection with an Entrance Panel, use this key to release the door lock of that Entrance Panel, when idle, the same key releases the door lock of the associated Entrance Panel.
Favorites key	Use this key to switch on the staircase light (basic configuration; for the other configurations refer to your installer).
Auto-switching on/scrolling key	This key has two functions: It can be used to switch on the camera of the associated Entrance Panel, and to scroll through the connected cameras and/or entrance panels.
Connection key	Use this key to answer a call: when a call is received, the key starts flashing, once the call is answered the key light is on steady. Touch again to end the call.
Wi-Fi LED	When there is no connection the Wi-Fi is disabled or works correctly. When it flashes red it indicates that the Wi-Fi is active but not connected to a network. When it is green and steady, the Classe 300X is exchanging data with the DOOR ENTRY APP (forwarding of call, auto-switching on).
Memo LED	When flashing, it indicates that there are unread and/or unlistened memos or message/s in the answering machine.
Bell exclusion LED	When on, it means that the call ringtone is disabled.

Home page

This page can show different contents based on the configuration mode (physical or advanced) and the device model. Below is the home page with all the functions enabled.



1. Screen off
2. If this symbol appears, [date and time must be updated](#)
3. App:
touch to display the [information](#) page where you find a QR code (download the QR Code reader from App Store or Google Play) that allows the download of the [DOOR ENTRY APP](#) to interact with your device.
You can disable the display from the info page.

Note: a domestic Wi-Fi with internet access is needed for the connection between the Classe300X video internal unit and the smartphone.

To use the service, the Customer must acquire the technical equipment which allows access to the Internet, on the basis of an agreement made by the Customer himself with an ISP (Internet Service Provider). BTicino plays no part in this.

The customer must install the [DOOR ENTRY APP](#) on his smartphone so that he can use some services which BTicino supplies as extras to the normal basic functions of the Classe 300X.

The services offered by means of the APP require being able to interact with Classe 300X remotely and through the Internet.

In these cases the integration and good working between Classe 300X and APP may depend on:

- a) quality of the Wi-Fi signal;
- b) type of access contract to the home internet;
- c) type of data contract on the smartphone.

When one of these 3 elements does not conform with the specifications required for product operation, BTicino accepts no responsibility for any faults.









The [DOOR ENTRY APP](#) operation with screen off (background) may be compromised by the applications installed on the smartphone that:

- optimise the use of the battery and the energy saving;
- protect the device (antivirus or similar programs)

The product in fact supports a VoIP streaming system. You must therefore check with your smartphone data network contract that it does not block it.

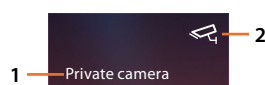

		Answering machine	Enable this function to record a call from the entrance panel. When a call is received and the call forwarding function is also active, you can still answer from all the associated devices, but the communication is not recorded.



Call forward enabling to the smartphones

This function allows you to forward the video door entry calls from the Entrance Panel to the associated smartphones.

The forwarding is differentiated in two modes:

- forward to all the smartphones;
- block calls to all the smartphones.

Enabling to all the smartphones

By means of this function, you enable the call forwarding from the Entrance Panel to all the smartphones both when the smartphone and the Classe 300X are connected to the same Wi-Fi network and when the smartphone is connected to a different mobile or Wi-Fi network from the one to which the device is connected.

Note: when the smartphone is connected to a mobile network the audio/video signal is only guaranteed for 3G networks or higher.

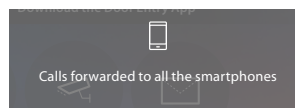

Block calls to all the smartphones

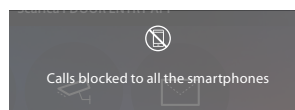

Functions

	Cameras	Touch to access the screen for the activation of the cameras of the system, and display the images recorded by them.
	Memo	Touch to access the screen used to write or record a memos, or display and listen to any memos present.
	Intercom	Touch to access the screen used communicated with other audio/video internal units installed in your apartment or in other apartments.
	Activations	Touch to access the screen where it is possible to enable certain actuators (e.g. door locks, garden light, etc.).
	Settings	Touch to access the screen where it is possible to customise the functions, to make the most of your device.

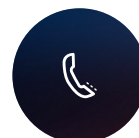

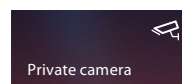

Answering machine

In this section it is possible to display the audio/video messages recorded from the Entrance Panel in your absence. For this to work, it is necessary to activate the function by pressing the relevant icon (A).



When a message has been recorded in the answering machine, LED (B) flashes, and the function icon shows a number indicating the new or unread messages (C).

1. Touch to enter the answering machine.



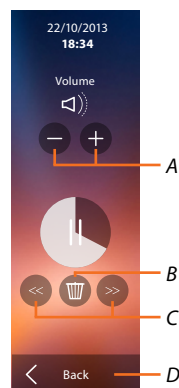

Cameras

This section can be used to monitor your home by enabling one of the cameras inside the apartment, the common areas (e.g. garages, garden), and at the entrance panels. After enabling a camera, it is possible to "scroll" (display in sequence) the other cameras.



1. Touch to display the cameras in your system.



2. Touch to activate the desired camera.

The display shows the images recorded by the active camera.
For the camera adjustments see [Answer a call](#).



3. Touch to display another camera (scrolling). When switching from one camera to the next, the key lights up.
4. If the camera belongs to an Entrance Panel, the key flashes. Touch it to activate audio communication.

To end camera display mode wait for the switching off time to elapse.

CCTV

This section can be used to monitor your home by enabling one of the video surveillance system cameras inside the apartment or the common areas (e.g. garages, garden).

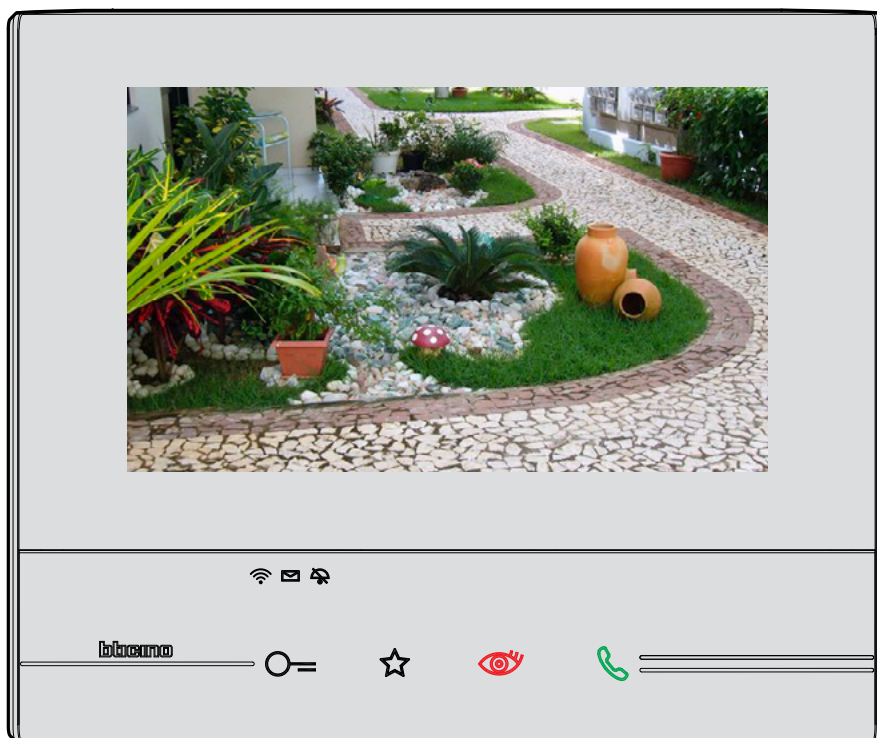


1. Touch to display the cameras in your system.



2. Touch to activate the desired camera.

The display shows the images recorded by the active camera.
For the camera adjustments see [Answer a call](#).



The image is displayed for three minutes. The camera cycling function is not included

Note: for the camera cycling or multi-vision function, a device performing these functions must be installed (e.g. Digital Video Recorder).

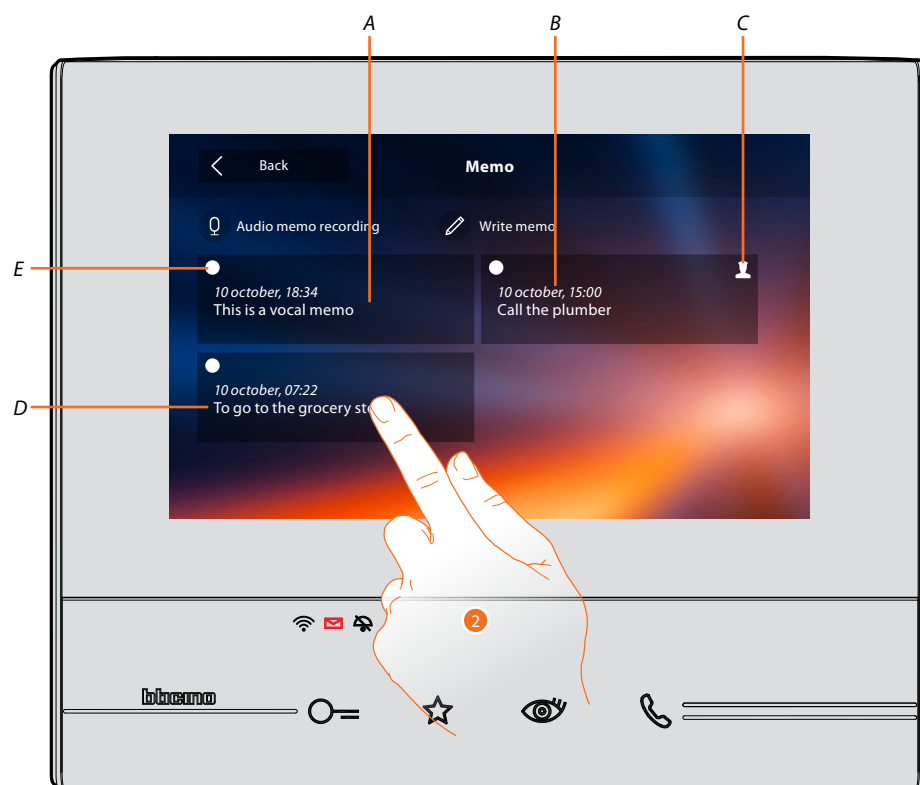
Memo

In this section it is possible to create memos, or display any memos left by other users, or by the switchboard. There are two types of memos: written memos and voice messages.



When a memo has been recorded in the answering machine, LED (B) flashes, and the function icon shows a number indicating the new or unread messages (A).

1. Touch to access the memos.



- A. Voice memo indication.
- B. Date/time of recording.
- C. Memo from the switchboard.
- D. Written memo preview.
- E. Memo status indicator:
 - ☐ unread memo;
 - ☒ read memo
- 2. Touch to open the memo.

Text memo



This screen can be used to display (C), modify (A) or delete (B) the memo text.

3. Touch to modify the memo.



4. Use the keypad to modify the memo.

5. Touch to save the modification.

Audio memo



This screen can be used to listen to the audio memo, or to delete it (A).

3. Touch to listen to the recording.



4. Touch to stop playback.

Intercom

This section can be used to communicate with other video/audio internal units installed in your home, or in other apartments.



1. Touch to display the available intercoms.



2. Touch to activate the communication with the desired intercom.



Key (A) lights up to indicate that the call is active.



When the recipient answers the call, the audio adjustment icons appear; see [Answer a call](#).

Note: when a call is received from the Entrance Panel while the internal unit is in "intercom" mode, the system follows the priority rules and ends the active call.

Note: only the devices supplied with additional power supply can display the caller address before the audio connection.

3. Touch to end the call.

Activations

This section can be used to enable certain actuators (e.g. door locks, garden light, etc.).



1. Touch to display the available activations.



2. Touch to activate the door lock.
Key (A) lights up to indicate that the activation has been successful.

Quick actions

On the right of the home page are the quick actions, if previously enabled in the [Settings/Quick Action](#) section, or if physically configured (maximum 4).

Touch these icons to directly enable the function without opening the specific screen.



1. Touch to directly enable the function (e.g. camera).

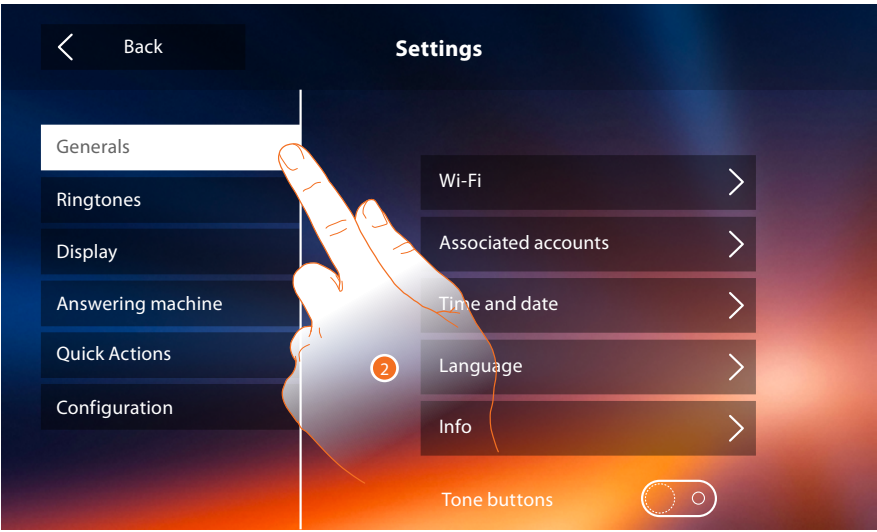

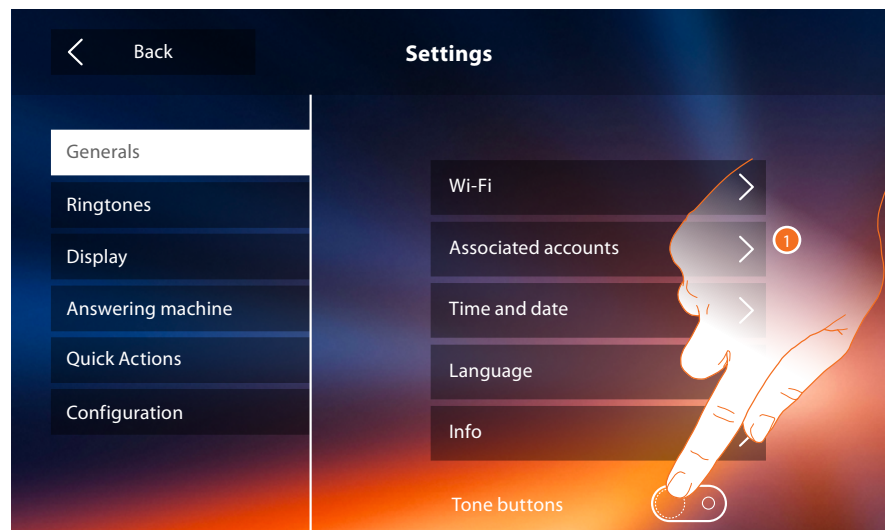

General settings

This section contains the general settings and device information.



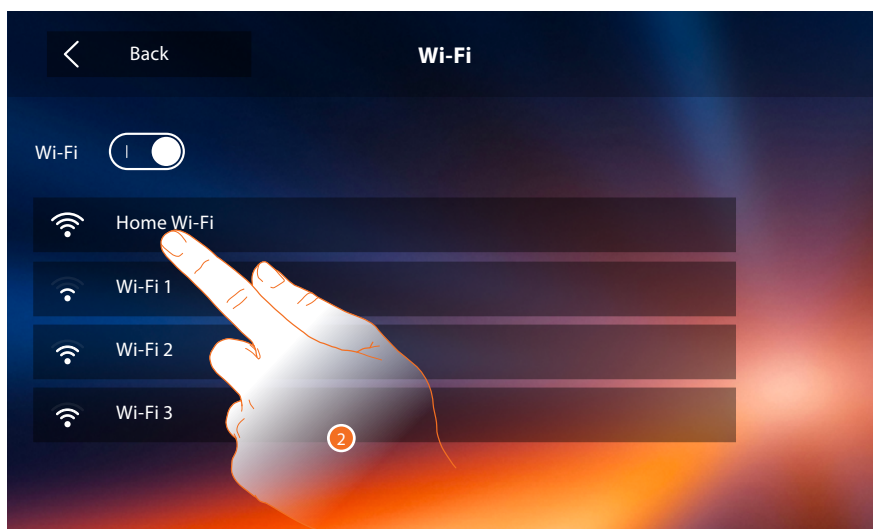
1. Enable/disable the sound when a key is pressed.

Wi-Fi

In this section it is possible to connect the device to your Wi-Fi network.



1. Touch to activate the function.



2. Select the domestic network to which you want to connect the device.
If the Wi-Fi signal is weak or non-existent check the [Wi-Fi installation rules](#).

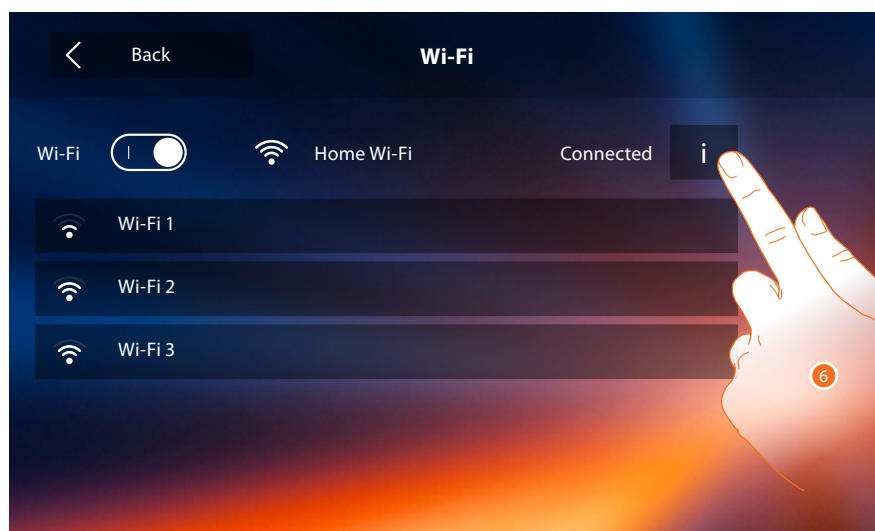
Note: your domestic network must have the following features:

- IEEE 802.11 b/g/n (2,4 GHz) 13 channels
- Encrypting and authentication methods supported:
- OPEN WPA-PSK networks
- TKIP WPA2-PSK included
- included AES WEP 64 bits (ASCII 5 figure or hexadecimal 10 figure codes)
- WEP 128 bits (ASCII 13 figure or hexadecimal 26 figure codes)
- WPS authentication (supported for WPA2-PSK)



3. Enter the password (if required).
4. Touch to display the unencrypted password.
5. Touch to activate the connection.

The device provides the display or modification of the network connection parameters



6. Touch to display or modify the network connection parameters.

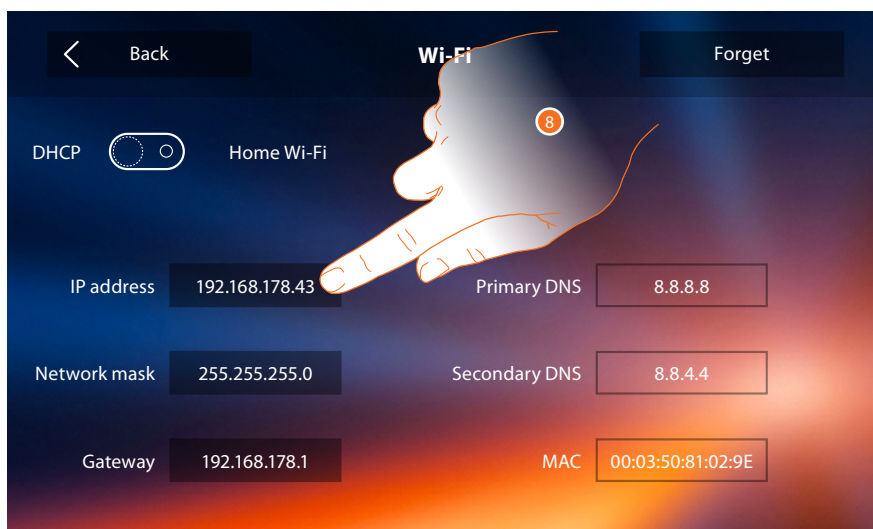


7. Touch to disable the DHCP mode and to manually modify the parameters.

- **IP address and Subnet mask:** typical parameters of TCP/IP protocol networks, necessary for the identification of the device within the local network.
- **Gateway:** IP address of the router/access point.

Note: before changing the default values, contact the network administrator.

In addition to preventing the service from becoming active, wrong values can cause malfunctioning during the communication of other network devices.



8. Touch to modify the device IP address.



9. Enter the new IP address.
10. Touch to save it.

Wi-Fi installation requirements

Check the Wi-Fi signal quality from the device display (see the Installer Manual). If it is low or does not exist, make sure that:

- the device is not installed near large metal objects or electric devices that can generate electromagnetic field;
- there are fewer possible walls between the router/access point and the Classe 300X.

Note: it is recommended that the Classe300X is installed near the Wi-Fi router.

Note: it is possible to install just one Classe300X for each Wi-Fi (SSID) network.

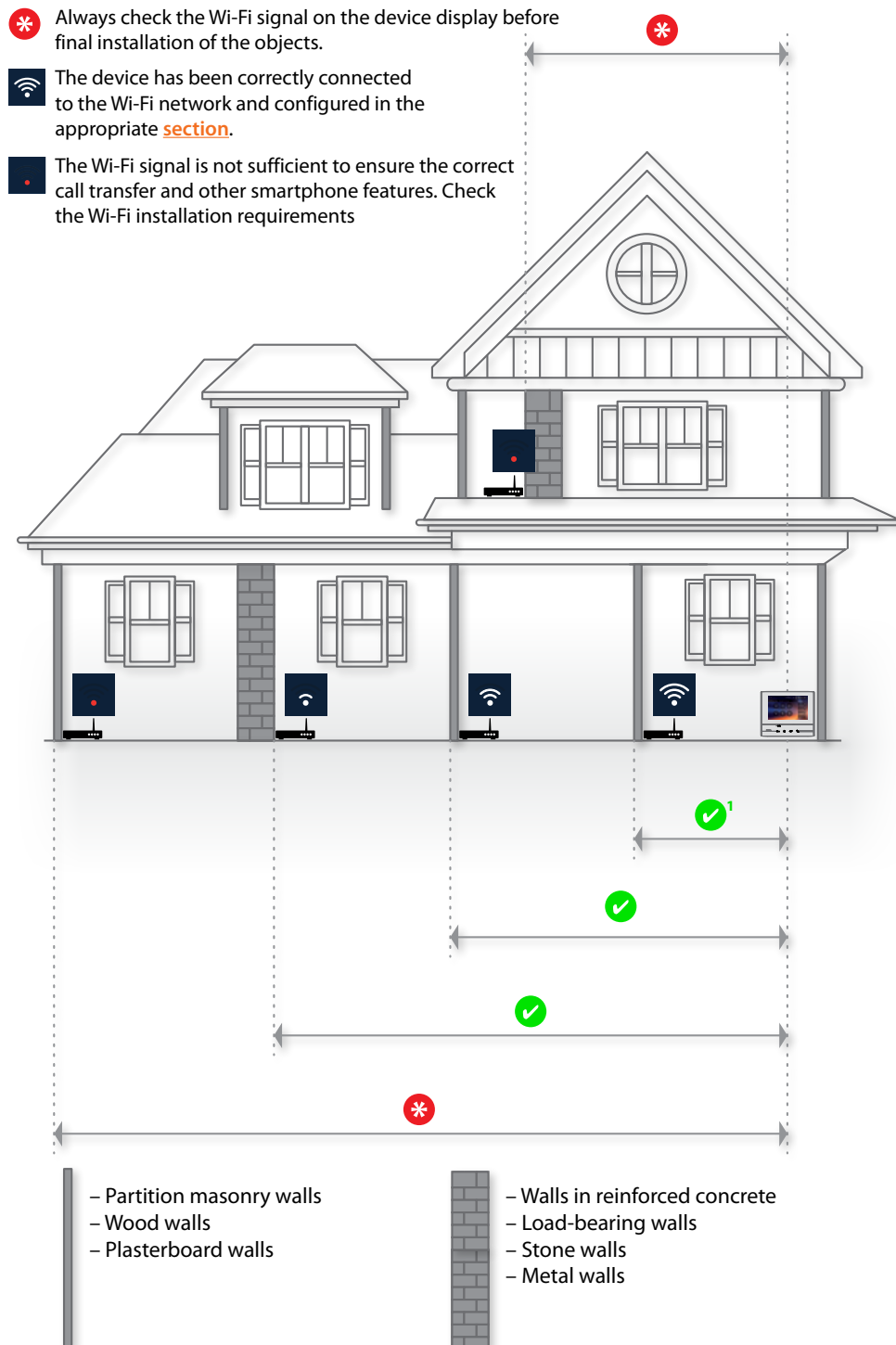

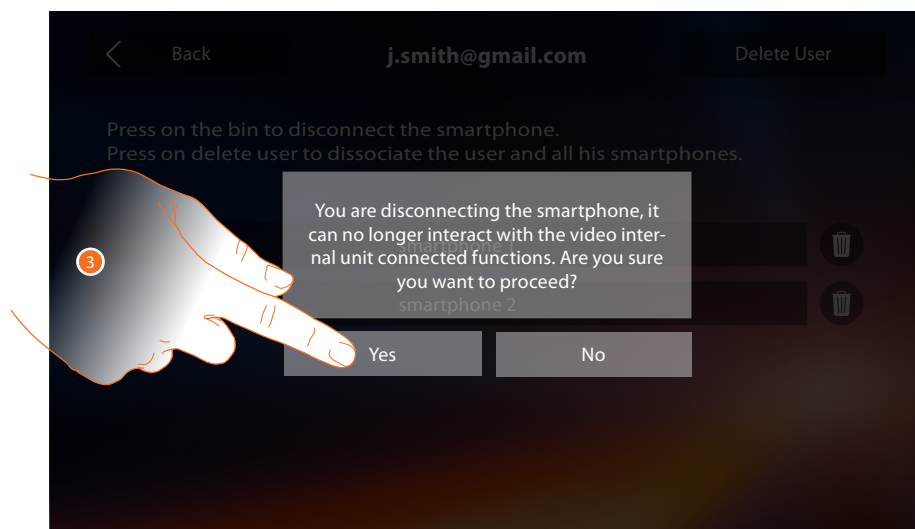

Time and date

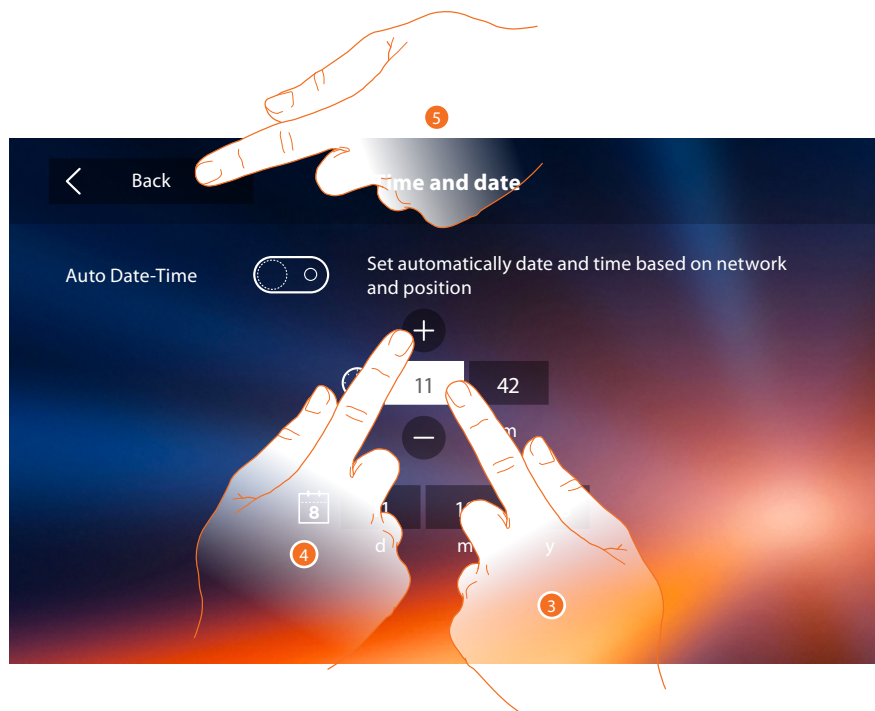
Set the current time and date.




1. Touch to set the automatic date and time.
You can set the date and time updated automatically by an NTP server. The Network Time Protocol (NTP) is a protocol to synchronise the system watches automatically, taking the correct data from the Internet.

2. Touch to disable the automatic date and time function and to manually set date and time.

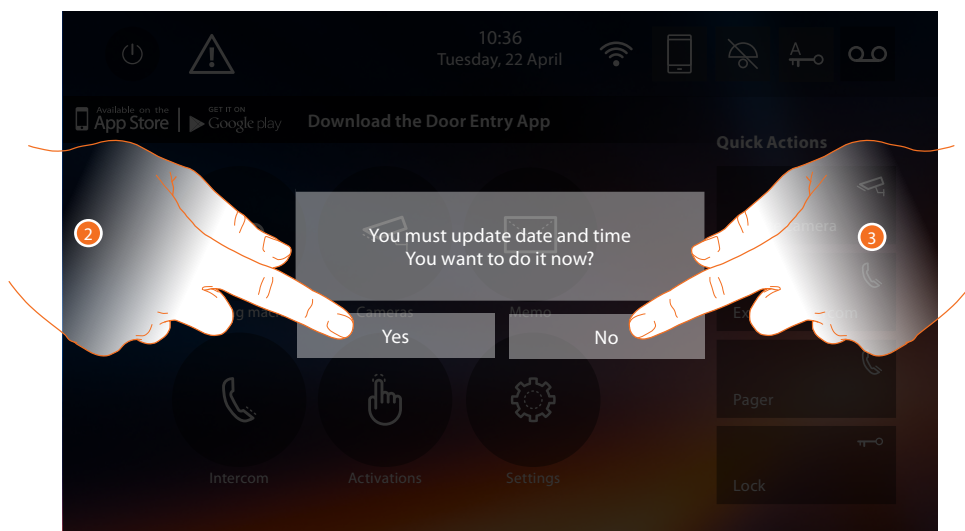


3. Touch the icon for the parameter to set (date or time); the icons to increase or decrease the value appear.
4. Touch to set it.
5. Touch to go back and save the settings.

If the symbol  appears in the Home page, touch it to update the date and time.




1. Touch to update the date and time.



2. Touch Yes to update the time and date.
The **time and date setting page** appears and, once updated, after a few seconds the symbol disappears from the Home page.

3. Touch NO to close the warning message; in this case the  symbol remains active in the Home page.

Language

Set the device language.



1. Touch the icon for the desired language.

Information

In this section it is possible to display some information about the device configuration, the QR Code to download the user manual and the **DOOR ENTRY APP** and you can decide to display the APP banner in the Home Page.



A. Display the configuration parameters.

Note: the **function** configurations or modification on the Classe 300X will be automatically reported also in the **DOOR ENTRY APP** after the first association to a smartphone and for any subsequent modification.

B. Enable/disable the display in the Home Page of the banner to download the **DOOR ENTRY APP**

C. Display if the device has been set as apartment master or slave.

D. Display if an additional power supply is present

E. Display if the **Professional Studio** function is active.

F. Display if the **Answering machine** function is active

G. Display the firmware version of the device.

H. Display the physical address of the Classe 300X.

I. Display the QR Code to download the User Manual.

L. Display the QR Code to download the **DOOR ENTRY APP** (Android version).

M. Display the QR Code to download the **DOOR ENTRY APP** (iOS version).

1. With a QR Code reader, read the code to install the **DOOR ENTRY APP** on your smartphone, that is necessary to manage the calls and other functions directly from your smartphone.

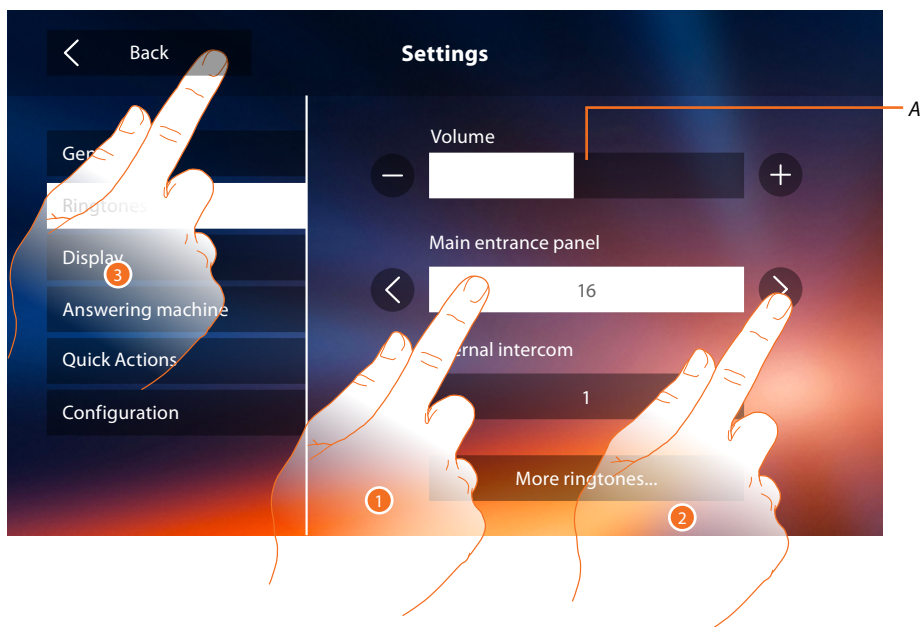
Using the **DOOR ENTRY APP** it is possible to:

- receive video calls from the Entrance Panels;
- manage the CCTV function;
- open the door locks of the Entrance Panels;
- call the Classe 300X;
- activate generic actuators wired on the system;
- update the Classe 300X firmware.

2. Touch to go back.

Ringtones

This section can be used to associate specific ringtones to certain events, and to adjust their volume.



A. *Adjust the ringtone volume.*

1. Touch the event to which to associate a specific ringtone; the selection icons appear.
2. Scroll through the available ringtones (16); they will be played back as you scroll through them.
3. Touch to go back and save the settings.

Events to which it is possible to associate ringtones:

Main Entrance Panel: call from the main Entrance Panel (S0)

Internal intercom: call from an intercom in your apartment.

Other ringtones...

S1, 2, 3 Entrance Panel: call from the SECONDARY Entrance Panel (S1; S2; S3)

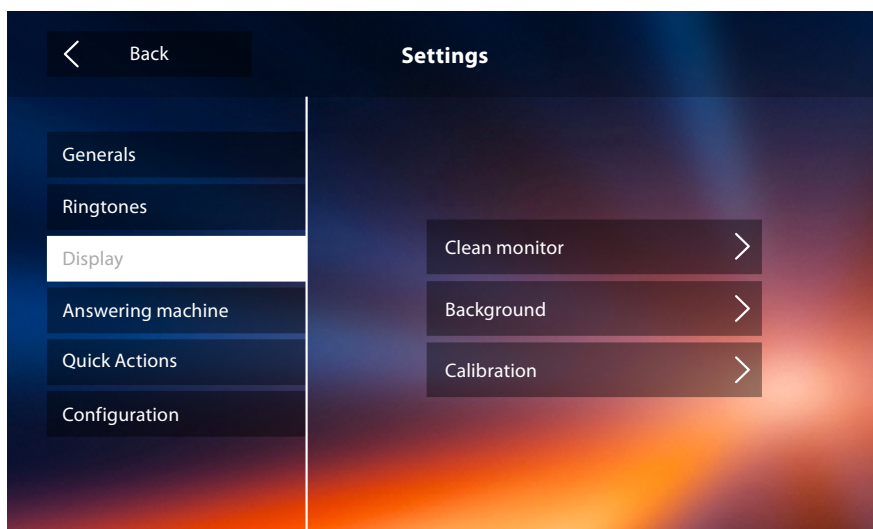
External intercom: call from an intercom of another apartment.

Call to the floor: call from the pushbutton outside your entrance door.

Notifications: memo from the switchboard.

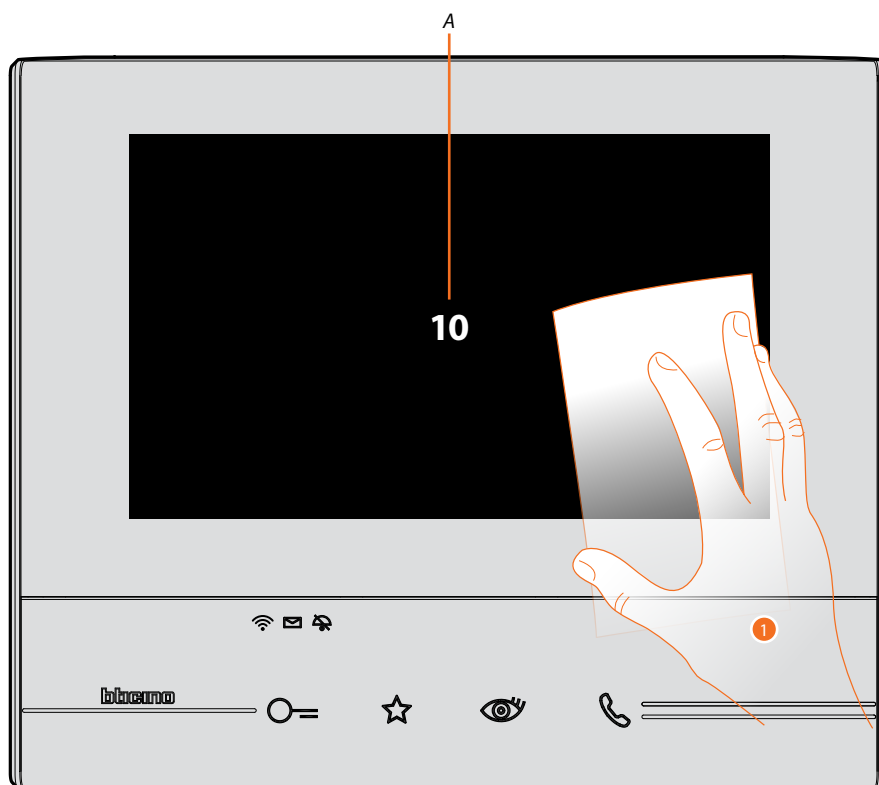
Display

This section is used to calibrate and clean the monitor, and to change the background image.



Clean monitor

It's used to disable the display and the keys for cleaning purposes, without the risk of sending unwanted commands.



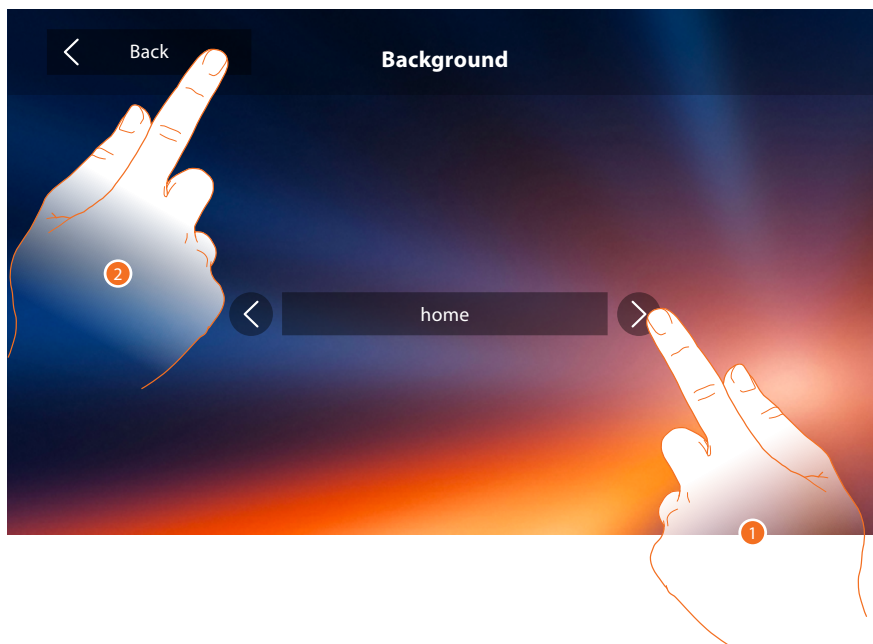
A. After touching the corresponding icon, the display remains in stand-by for 10 seconds.

1. During this period, it is possible to clean the monitor and the keys.

Note: do not clean with solvents, thinners etc. or abrasive products. Only use a soft cloth.

Background

It gives the possibility to change the background image of the device.



1. Scroll through the available images to get a background preview.
2. Touch to go back and save the settings.

Calibration

It can be used to adjust the touch pressure for the display.



1. Touch the "cross" symbol on the display as it moves to all 5 positions. At the end, the **Ok** icon appears at the corners of the display. Touch it to complete the calibration procedure.

Answering machine

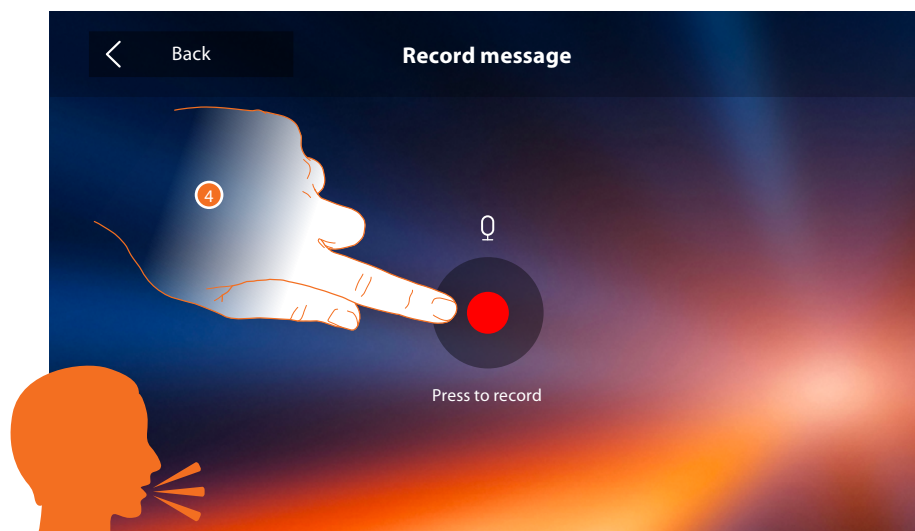
This page can be used to set the quality of the videos recorded by the answering machine, or to record, enable, disable the welcome message.



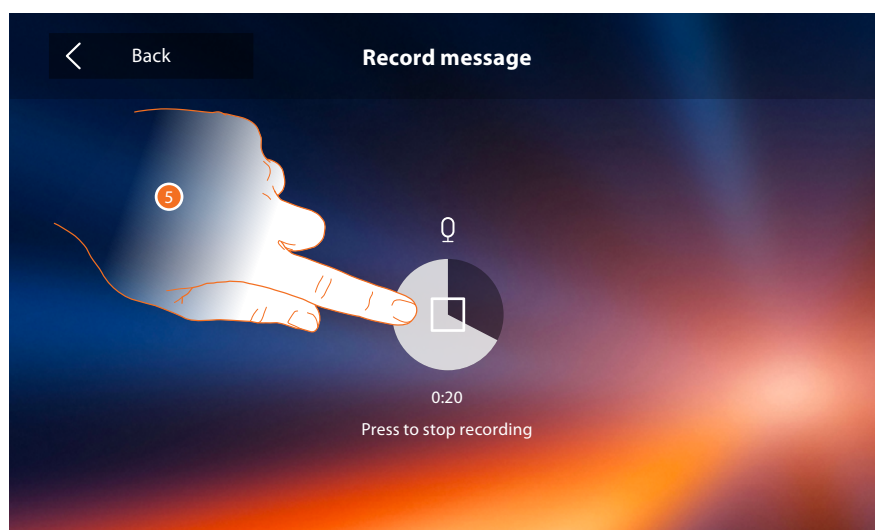
A. Enable/disable the welcome message.

1. Set if video messages must be recorded in high resolution (maximum 25 x 15 sec. messages), or in low resolution (maximum 150 x 15 sec. messages).
2. Touch to record a welcome message.
3. Touch to go back and save the settings.

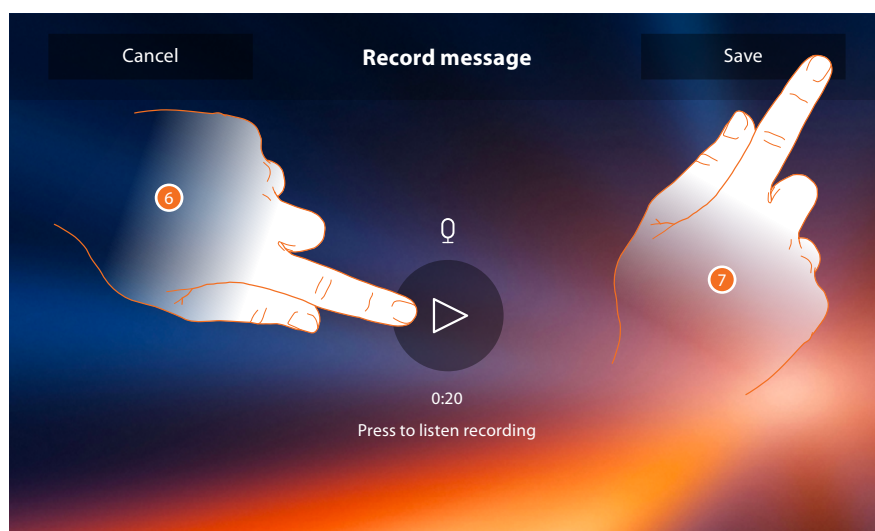
Note: the most recent message overwrites the oldest one.

Inductive loop

This function enables the device to be used by people wearing hearing aids.



To use this function, switch the acoustic device to the T position.



To ensure correct magnetic coupling between the IU and the acoustic device, we recommend a position in front of the device, at a distance of 25-35cm.
It is reminded that the presence of metal and background noise generated by electric/electronic devices (e.g. computer) may compromise the performance and the quality of the coupling device.

Door status

This function indicates the status of the door lock only for systems preset with appropriate actuator.

If open the "door lock LED" flashes, and if closed, the LED stays off.

The function cannot be activated together with the Office function.



A. LED flashing = door lock open.

Office

This function gives the possibility of setting the automatic opening of the door lock in case of call from the Entrance Panel.

Activation is possible after enabling by the installer in the configuration section, but is not possible when using the "Door Status" function.



A. LED flashing = active function.

Paging

This function can be used to send voice messages using the microphone of the device through the speakers of the Sound system.

Door Entry App

Introduction

You can interact with your Classe 300X using the free DOOR ENTRY APP.

After [registering](#) and [authenticating](#), you must make the [association with the device](#); at this point you can:

- answer a video door entry call from the Entrance Panel;
- CALL HOME (call your Classe 300X)
- display the images from the entrance panels and cameras;
- open the door lock of the Entrance Panels;
- activate generic actuators wired on the system;
- update the firmware of your Classe 300X.
- enable the video answering function and display the audio/video messages recorded from the Entrance Panel.



To download the DOOR ENTRY APP (for iOS devices from App Store, for Android devices from Play Store), scan the QR Code with your smartphone:

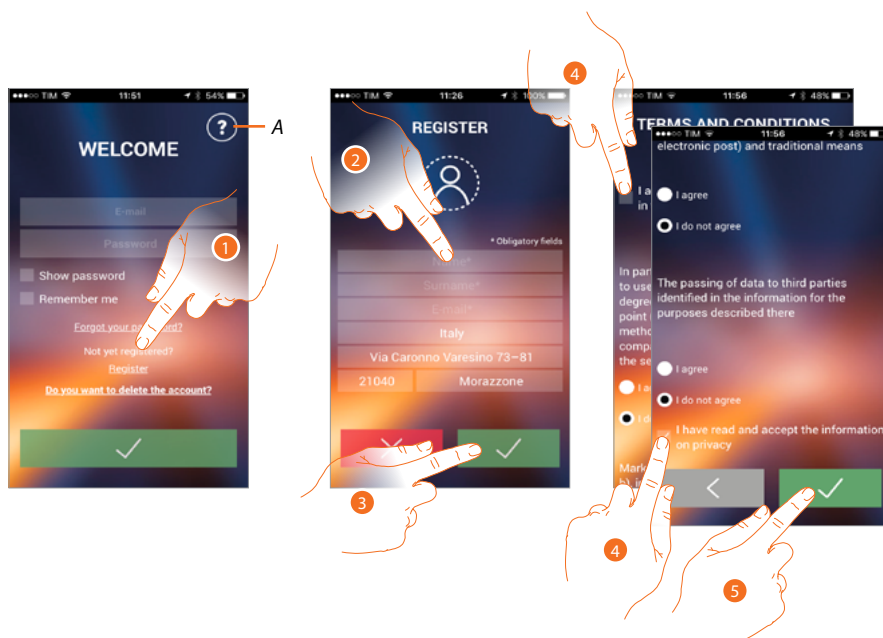

Account registration

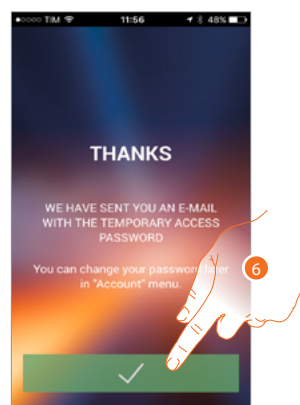
You must first register to be able to use the **DOOR ENTRY APP** and thus use the interface functions with your Classe 300X.

After opening the App follow the registration instructions: when the account has been created it will be common to all the connected Legrand/BTicino device App



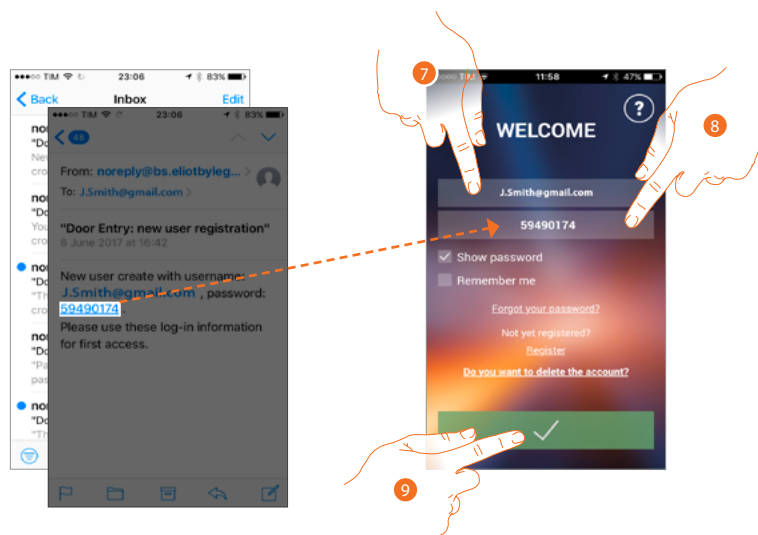
